Regular Rate: Regular rate is based on the hour, the rate will be charged in full hour increments.

Performance Rate: Performance rate will be based on a three and one half hours minimum. Any additional hours will be charged at one and one half time the hourly rate.

Overtime: All hours worked between 12 midnight and 8:00am and beyond forty (40) hours for the same Licensee shall be paid at one and one half regular time rate.

Holidays: Holiday pay will be at two times the regular rate. Holidays shall be as follows: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.

Meal Periods: The crew shall receive a meal period of one hour after commencement of work of five hours. In the event the crew is not permitted such a meal period, the crew will receive double time rate until such meal period is received.

Minimum Call: Four hours shall be the minimum call for move-in. Three hours shall be the minimum call for move-out.

Administrative Charge: Administrative charge of 27.5% will be added to the total labor charge. This is to help cover workers compensation insurance, liability insurance and other administrative cost.
